
# Azed No. 2,636 'Christmas Cards' - Competition Puzzle



Eighteen clues lead to words/phrases from which the letters CARD (in that order but not necessarily consecutively) must be omitted before entry. Each of these clues contains a definition of the full unmutilated answer and a cryptic indication of the entry itself (only coincidentally a real word). Every 'card' word/phrase is in Chambers except two (one of them being of two words), both of which may be verified on the Internet. Two non-thematic entries are not in Chambers, one a common two-word phrase and the other a geographical proper name. Bracketed numbers indicate the length of grid entries throughout.

Competitors should submit with their entries a clue to a word/phrase of their own choice (maximum 12 letters in its unmutilated form) following the style of all the other thematic clues.
